Caitlin Alohilani Presets

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. After purchasing your preset collection on Etsy, save the download to your computer.
- 2. Move files from your computer, to your phone. This can be done via Dropbox, Google Drive, or the email app on your phone. Simply email the preset DNG files to yourself, or save in a folder, and then download them to your phone.
- 3. Download the Adobe Lightroom Mobile app from the App Store.
- 4. Set up your account in the Lightroom Mobile app.
- 5. Open the DNG preset files in the Lightroom Mobile app.
- 6. Open one DNG file within Lightroom Mobile. Click the three dots in the upper right-hand corner of your app/phone screen. Click "Create Preset."
- 7. Create a name for the preset. You may use the name of the existing file, and I would recommend adding in a description of what the preset is best used for, as described in the file name (e.g. indoors, bright sunlight, nights out, etc.). The presets will work best for photos with the lighting conditions as described, though you may have fun testing them out on any photo.
- 8. Check all boxes except for "Geometry." Click the check mark in the upper right-hand corner of the app screen to save the preset.
- 9. THAT'S IT! Now the preset settings are saved. Repeat steps 6-8 to save all individual presets within the preset collection (a total of 8) to your Lightroom Mobile app.
- 10. Upload and open any photos in Lightroom Mobile using the blue button in the bottom right-hand corner of the app screen.
- 11. To view your saved presets, scroll to the right on the editing panel at the bottom of the app screen, once your photo is open.
- 12. Click "Presets."
- 13. Search for your saved presets, then in one click, apply all the settings from a given preset to your photo.
- 14. The only other edits I might suggest you make are to "Crop," to straighten your image, and to check the exposure setting within the "Light" button, and temp/tint settings within the "Color" button. These may vary slightly with your original photo, depending on the conditions it was shot in. Make adjustments to your liking.
- 15. Click on the icon of a box with an arrow in the upper right-hand corner of the app screen to export the image to your Camera Roll.
- 16. Share away! Don't forget to tag @caitlinalohilaniphoto and #caitlinalohilanipresets so that I may share in your joys of editing!
